


Bell Street Project

Traffic Control Phasing Open House

Thursday July 21, 2016 6 PM to 8 PM



The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) in conjunction with the City of Amarillo and the Amarillo Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) will conduct an open house on Thursday, July 21, 2016, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the TxDOT District Office Building H located at 5715 Canyon Drive, Amarillo, Texas, 79110.

This meeting will be an open house “come and go” format with no formal presentation to present the proposed Traffic Control Phasing (TCP) for the proposed improvements to Interstate Highway 40 (IH 40) at Bell Street in Potter County, Texas. Information and display exhibits related to the TCP will be provided. The proposed project involving the replacement two of the three Bell Street bridges over IH 40 and to improve the intersection and frontage road approaches was presented during the public meeting held on April 21, 2016. The improvements address traffic operations, mobility, and safety.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 16, 2014, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.
