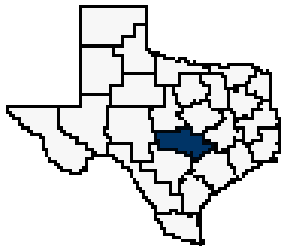




## DISTRICT PROFILE

### MAJOR PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- I-35 from Rundberg to US 290 East: add three new flyovers at US 183, reconstruct St. Johns Avenue bridge and construct bypass lanes—\$124.2 million
- I-35 from Stassney to William Cannon: reconstruct bridges and widen roadway to enhance safety/mobility—\$79 million
- I-35 at Oltorf: reconstruct bridge, extend entrance/exit lanes and add U-turn lanes—\$42.6 million
- US 183 South: construct six tolled mainlanes and four to six non-tolled general purpose lanes from Springdale Road to SH 71 in east Austin—\$743 million (CTRMA project)

### PLANNED MAJOR PROJECTS:

- Mobility35: upgrades along 79-mile corridor from Bell/Williamson to Hays/Comal County line— est. \$8.1 billion for 33 miles between RM 1431 and SH 45 SE; \$800 million for remaining Wilco; \$1.6 billion for Hays County
- US 183 North: construct two managed lanes and one general purpose lane in each direction from SH 45 North to Loop 1— est. \$480 million
- SH 130: add toll lane in each direction from SH 46 North to US 290; and from US 290 to SH 71— est. \$195 million
- Loop 360: construct over/underpasses at nine signalized intersections between US 183 and SH 71— est. \$250 million
- Oak Hill Parkway: long-term upgrades to US 290 and SH 71— est. \$440 million

**MAINTENANCE:** We spend approximately \$120 million annually on maintaining our system, including seal coats/overlays, pavement repairs and other preventive maintenance projects, to address mobility and improve safety on Texas highways.

**CORRIDORS:** The Austin District's strategic corridors include I-35, US 290, US 183, US 281, US 79, US 77, SH 71, SH 21, SH 96, SH 195, SH 130 toll road, SH 45, Loop 1 (MoPac), Loop 360 and RM 620.

**SAFETY:** Safety is our top priority. As such, the Austin District has awarded 30 safety projects worth \$23.9 million that consist of widening shoulders, resurfacing, safety lighting and implementing other important safety enhancements.
