AUSTIN DISTRICT ANNUAL BIKE MEETING

On Thursday, April 3, 2014, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Austin District will conduct a public meeting to discuss bicycle accommodation and use on state roadways. The public meeting will be held from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. at TxDOT's Riverside Campus, Building 200, Room 1A.1, located at 200 East Riverside, Austin, Texas.

The purpose of the public meeting is to provide information regarding transportation projects and programs that might affect bicycle use on the state system in the Austin area. The Austin District consists of 11 counties, including Bastrop, Blanco, Burnet, Caldwell, Gillespie, Hays, Mason, Lee, Llano, Travis, and Williamson Counties. Maps and other drawings showing the existing state roadway system and upcoming projects on the state system will be displayed.

All citizens are invited to attend the public meeting and provide input. Verbal and written comments regarding bicycle use of the state system in the Austin District are requested and may be presented either at the meeting or in writing within 15 days after the meeting. To be included in the official record of the public meeting, written comments must be postmarked on or before Friday, April 18, 2014. Any interested citizen may request that this meeting be formalized into a public hearing by submitting a written request to Bonnie Lister at the address mentioned above on or before Thursday, March 20, 2014. In the event such request is received, the public meeting to be held April 3, 2014, will include a formal public hearing beginning at 6 p.m.
