183 North Mobility Project
U.S. HIGHWAY (US) 183 from STATE HIGHWAY (SH) 45 NORTH to STATE LOOP 1 (MoPac)**

On July 8, 2014, the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority (Mobility Authority) and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will host an Open House on proposed mobility improvements to US 183 from SH 45 North to MoPac. No formal presentation will be given, and attendees are invited to come-and-go at their convenience. The Open House will be held:

The 183 North Mobility Project will thoroughly analyze US 183 between SH 45 North and MoPac and determine the best alternatives for managing congestion, as well as providing a reliable transit route and facilitating reliable emergency response. The purpose of the Open House is to discuss the purpose and need of the project, alternatives being developed, and draft evaluation criteria, and to gather additional public input on the project.

Verbal and written comments will be accepted at the Open House. A court reporter will be available to accept verbal comments.
