

PROJECT OVERVIEW



From SH 71W to US 183N

Ranch to Market Road 620 is a 23.2-mile road running from SH 71 in Bee Cave in Travis County passing south of Lake Travis, west and north of Austin, and south of Cedar Park before ending at I-35 in Round Rock in Williamson County. The road has major intersections with SH 71, RM 2222, US 183, SH 45 and I-35.

RM 620 provides primary access to the southern Lake Travis area of Travis County and the southernmost tip of Williamson County. Through most of its length RM 620 functions as both a local thoroughfare and commuter highway. In many cases it is the sole access to many subdivisions, businesses and schools. It is also the primary access route to Lake Travis- area recreation facilities.


This feasibility study will deal only with that 18.8-mile segment from SH 71 North to US 183 North.

Current Conditions

Travis County's rapid growth has placed increased demand on this already congested highway. The Hill Country terrain, limited route alternatives, constrained rights of way and environmental sensitivity will challenge potential solutions.

Proposed Improvements

Planning for RM 620 will address short- and long-term needs, and currently no funding is available for any improvements. TxDOT will be working with local communities and residents to determine the need and feasibility for proposed improvements to serve existing and future growth.
