TURN LANE EXTENSIONS ON LOOP 360 TO TAKE PLACE THIS WEEK

Pavement repairs, left-turn lane improvements enhance safety, mobility in northwest Austin

AUSTIN — Traveling on Loop 360 will become easier as the Texas Department of Transportation begins a pavement repair and left-turn lane improvement project in Travis County.

Starting today, crews will begin extending the left-turn lane along Loop 360 in three locations, including:

- northbound Loop 360 and Spicewood Springs Road for a distance of 1200 feet
- northbound Loop 360 and Bluffstone Drive for a distance of 665 feet
- southbound Loop 360 and Spicewood Springs Road for a distance of 990 feet

The longer turn lanes will allow more space for motorists to prepare to turn and not block drivers using the through lanes. Currently, the left-turn lanes are approximately 120-200 feet, depending on the location. Work is expected to last about one week and will take place in the shoulder area during the day, minimizing the impact to traffic.

Once the left-turn lane extensions are complete, crews will make pavement repairs at the intersection of Loop 360 and US 183. Work could begin as early as June 9, weather permitting, and will take place nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Crews anticipate completing the work later that same week.

Signs have been placed in both directions along the highway to alert motorists to the work. Motorists should allow extra time to travel through this area during the affected hours. TxDOT asks the traveling public to be patient and remain aware when traveling through the work zone.
