



## NOTICE OF OPEN HOUSE

On Tuesday, November 1, 2011, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct an open house to present proposed intersection improvements along State Loop 360 from US 183 to US 290 in Travis County, Texas and to solicit public comment. The proposed project would include the consideration of innovative intersection improvements at existing intersections along State Loop 360. It is anticipated that the proposed project would not require the acquisition of new right-of-way or easements, and therefore, no residences or businesses would be displaced. However, the improvements are still in the conceptual phase.

The purpose of the proposed project is to improve operational efficiency and relieve congestion and delays at intersections and along the corridor.

The open house will be held from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. at Westlake High School, 4100 Westbank Drive, Austin, Texas. During the open house, displays, including the proposed intersections improvement design options and other project information, will be available for viewing. A presentation will not be given during the open house; however, members of the project team will be available to answer questions.

All interested citizens are invited to attend this open house and to provide input. Verbal and written comments may be presented at the open house or written comments may be submitted via regular postal mail. To be included in the official record of the open house, written comments not submitted at the open house must be received by Monday, November 14, 2011.
