Pursuant to Transportation Code, §21.111, and Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, §30.209, the Texas Department of Transportation will conduct a public hearing to receive comments from interested parties concerning financial assistance of \$50,000 per grant per eligible airport under the Routine Airport Maintenance Program (RAMP) and approval of financial assistance at the following locations: Chambers County (Anahuac), City of Atlanta, City of Clifton, City of Fort Worth (Meacham), Gillespie County, City of Gonzales, City of Hillsboro, Fayette County, City of Lampasas, City of Levelland and Hockley County, City of Liberty, Angelina County, City of Midlothian and City of Waxahachie, City of Paris, City of Quanah, City of Rockwall, City of San Marcos and Texas State Technical College – Waco.

The public hearing will be held on Monday, July 25, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. at 150 East Riverside, South Tower, 5th Floor Conference Room 107, Austin, Texas 78704. Any interested person may appear and offer comments, either orally or in writing; however, questioning of those making presentations will be reserved exclusively to the presiding officer as may be necessary to ensure a complete record. While any person with pertinent comments will be granted an opportunity to present them during the course of the hearing, the presiding officer reserves the right to restrict testimony in terms of time and repetitive content. Organizations, associations, or groups are encouraged to present their commonly held views, and same or similar comments, through a representative member where possible.
