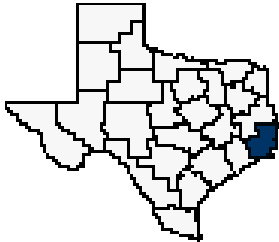




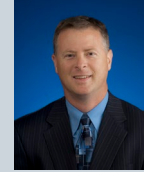
DISTRICT PROFILE

The Beaumont District is responsible for the design, construction and maintenance of nearly 2,400 miles of state highway, and more than 1,500 bridges in Southeast Texas. The district covers eight counties and is located along the Gulf Coast and adjacent to Louisiana.

MAJOR PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- I-10 – Reconstruct I-10 between Orange, Texas, and Louisiana state line – \$68 million (completion in 2021)
- I-10 – Add lanes between SH 73 and Walden Road – \$279 million (three separate projects \$43 million; \$108 million; \$128 million)
- US 59 Expansion/I-69 – US 59 through Cleveland in Liberty County – Expansion of US 59 to interstate standards – \$102 million
- US 69 – Extend frontage roads across Pine Island Bayou - \$11 million
- US 69 – Add lanes between the northern I-10/US 69 interchange and the LNVA Canal - \$31 million
- SH-99/Grand Parkway – Construct segments H & I-1 – US 59 to I-10

PLANNED MAJOR PROJECTS:

- I-10 – Reconfigure the northern and southern I-10/US 69 interchanges - \$500 million
- US 69 – Add lanes between LNVA Canal and Tram Road - \$21 million
- I-10 – Rebuild I-10 as an overpass over FM 3180. Widen FM 3180 - \$38 million
- SH 63 – Replace bridge at Sabine River - \$19 million
- I-10 – Add lanes between Orange and Louisiana state line - \$50 million
- US 69 – Reconfigure interchange at SH 73 - \$70 million
- US 69 – Add lanes from Warren to north of Kountze - \$140 million

MAINTENANCE: The district annually spends approximately \$41 million on routine maintenance.

CORRIDORS: The district’s major thoroughfares include I-69/US 59, I-10, US 69, US 96, US 190, US 90, SH 105 and SH 99.

SAFETY: Throughout fiscal year 2019, approximately \$6.5 million will be spent on rumble strips, increased superelevation, additional paved shoulders, installing chevrons, safety treating, lighting, and traffic signal upgrades.
