## NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

### Interstate Highway 10 (I-10)

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a PUBLIC MEETING to discuss the proposed improvements to I-10 from State Highway (SH) 73 in Chambers County to Hamshire Rd. in Jefferson County. The meeting details are as follows:

The purpose of the meeting is to allow the public the opportunity to view and comment on the proposed improvements to I-10. **There will be no formal presentation.** The purpose of the project is to improve safety and increase mobility by reconstructing and widening I-10 to three lanes in each direction, from SH 73 to Hamshire Rd. Each lane will be 12 ft. wide, with 10ft. shoulders on each side. The bridge at FM 1663 would be replaced and widened and the overpass at Brush Island Rd. would be replaced. No additional right of way will be needed for this project, and thus, no displacements are planned. **The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 16, 2014, and executed by the Federal Highway Administration and TxDOT.**

Location maps, geometric design, and other information concerning this project will be available at the public meeting. All interested citizens are invited to attend this meeting to provide input regarding the proposed project. Written comments may be presented at the public meeting. In order to be included in the public meeting record for this project, comments must be submitted no later than Thursday, March 17, 2016.
