**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**  
**Interstate Highway 10 (I-10)**  
**From Hamshire Road to Farm to Market (FM) 365**  
**Widening and Reconstruction**  
**CSJ: 0739-02-161**  
**Jefferson County, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration, is proposing to widen and reconstruct I-10 from Hamshire Road to FM 365 in Jefferson County to improve safety and increase mobility. TxDOT, as the lead agency, will host an open house PUBLIC MEETING to discuss the proposed improvements to I-10. The meeting details are as follows:

The purpose of the meeting is to allow the public the opportunity to view and comment on the proposed improvements to I-10. The meeting will be conducted in an open house format, so attendees can come at their convenience. There will be no formal presentation. The existing interstate highway consists of four 12-foot wide travel lanes (two in each direction) with variable width inside and outside shoulders and a grass median with cable barrier. The proposed project would widen and reconstruct I-10 from four to six travel lanes (three in each direction) to provide 12-foot wide travel lanes, 10-foot wide outside shoulder, and 10-foot wide inside shoulder with a concrete median barrier. Other project components include reconstructing the I-10 interchanges with Hamshire Road and with FM 365. Additionally, the bridge structures at Taylor Bayou will be replaced and structures at other water crossings within the project limits may be widened or replaced.

All work is proposed within the existing right-of-way (ROW). No additional ROW or permanent/temporary easement is required; therefore, no displacements or relocations of residences and businesses are necessary. A U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Permit under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act is anticipated. *The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 16, 2014, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.*

Project maps, design drawings, and other informational exhibits concerning this proposed project will be available to review at the public meeting. All interested citizens are invited to attend this meeting to provide input regarding the proposed project. Written comments may be presented at the public meeting or submitted no later than Wednesday, November 30, 2016, in order to be included in the public meeting record.
