

SH 105 Public Hearing Plantersville Interchange

SH 105 at FM 1774
Tuesday, January 27, 2015
6:00 p.m.
High Point Elementary School



The Bryan District of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a public hearing to present proposed improvements to the intersection of SH 105 at FM 1774. The proposed project limits extend from 0.53-miles west of FM 1774 to 0.65-miles east of FM 1774. The hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, January 27, 2015, at 6:00 p.m. at the High Point Elementary School on SH 105 west of Plantersville. Project information, including a project location map, the planned layout and environmental study will be available for viewing by the public prior to the formal hearing proceedings. These documents will also be available at the Bryan District Office at 2591 North Earl Rudder Freeway in Bryan. A brief presentation describing the project will be followed by an opportunity for public comments.

TxDOT previously planned to construct an interchange of SH 105 with FM 1774 bridging over the existing roadway. Although this design may be warranted in the future, TxDOT is currently electing to build an improved at grade intersection of SH 105 at FM 1774. The proposed project is needed to address safety concerns related to traffic accidents associated with the intersection. Construction is tentatively targeted to begin in the summer of 2015.

Approximately 10.5 acres of additional right-of-way will be required to accommodate the improved intersection. There would be no relocation of homes or businesses.

The placement of temporary or permanent dredge or fill material into potentially jurisdictional waters of the U. S. would be authorized under NWP 14 and NWP 23 with a Pre-Construction Notification (PCN).

All interested citizens are invited to attend this hearing. Comments may be presented at the hearing or in writing to Mr. Chad L.
