The Bryan District of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will be holding an open house meeting regarding plans to enhance freight mobility and address congestion along the IH 45 corridor. The project limits are from SH 19 to 2 miles north of SH 75, with a length of approximately 9 miles. Proposed improvements include widening to six travel lanes with a center concrete barrier, adding collector-distributor lanes, and reconstructing ramps and frontage roads.

This meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, November 29, 2016 from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. in the Veterans Conference Center, located at 455 SH 75 North in Huntsville. The plans under consideration will be on display and TxDOT staff will be available to discuss the proposed project. Since this is an open house format, no formal presentation is planned. Interested citizens are invited to attend and may come and go at their convenience.
