The Bryan District of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), is proposing to widen I-45 (within the existing Right-of-Way) from the Montgomery County Line to SH 19 in Huntsville, Walker County. The purpose of this project is to improve safety and mobility along this portion of I-45.
