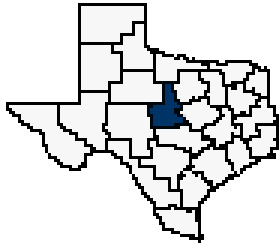




## DISTRICT PROFILE

The Brownwood District plans, designs, builds, operates and maintains the state transportation system in its counties. The district primarily conducts asset preservation and safety projects that are vital in rural areas of the state. The Brownwood District experiences generally warm, dry weather, with extended drought conditions, along with occasional spells of icy, winter weather. The wide-ranging weather patterns create challenges for maintenance crews and designers to maintain district assets and assure the safety of the traveling public.

### MAJOR PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- I-20 in Eastland County, at Ranger Hill: Realign Roadway and add frontage roads – \$76 million
- US 84 in Brown County: Replace railroad underpass – \$10.5 million
- US 180 in Stephens County: Reconstruct urban roadway in Breckenridge – \$11.4 million
- US 377, McCulloch County: Reconstruct existing two-lane highway in Brady \$9 million (Spring 2018)
- US 183 in Eastland County: Reconstruct urban roadway in Rising Star – \$10 million (Spring 2018)

### PLANNED MAJOR PROJECTS:

- SH 6 in Comanche County: Reconstruct urban roadway in De Leon – \$10 million (2019)
- US 377 in McCulloch County: Reconstruct existing two-lane highway in Brady – \$6 million (Spring 2018)
- FM 45, San Saba County: Reconstruct existing two-lane highway - estimated \$13 million
- SH 6 in Eastland County: Reconstruct and widen urban roadway - estimated \$9 million
- US 281 S, Lampasas County: Widen undivided four-lane roadway to divided four-lane roadway with flush median - estimated \$10.5 million

**MAINTENANCE:** Each year, the district spends approximately \$10 million on sealcoating projects and several million dollars rehabilitating I-20 and other major corridors.

**CORRIDORS:** The Brownwood District's priority corridor efforts focus on I-20, US 183, US 84, US 377, US 67 and US 190.
