TxDOT TO HOST A PUBLIC MEETING IN WHEELER

Proposed Super 2 Project to be discussed

CHILDRESS – The Texas Department of Transportation, (TxDOT) will host a public meeting on Monday, December 15, 2014. The meeting will be held from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Wheeler Ag and Family Life Center, 7939 U.S. HWY 83, Wheeler, TX 79096.

An open house will begin at 6:00 p.m. and will provide information and exhibits with schematics related to the project. A short presentation by TxDOT personnel will be conducted followed by a public comment period.

The purpose of the meeting is to present information on the proposed Super 2 project that is scheduled to let in July 2015. The limits for this project are from the north city limits of Wheeler to the Hemphill county line.
