

The Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT") hereby issues this Addendum #1 to the Request for Qualifications (the "RFQ") dated June 1, 2012 that was issued by TxDOT to prospective Proposers for the US 77 Upgrade from Kingsville to Driscoll Project (the "Project").

Initially capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings set forth in the RFQ.

Part A, Section 6.1(F) regarding correspondence is hereby revised as follows:

(F) Any official information regarding the Project will be disseminated from TxDOT's office on Department letterhead or on the Project Website. Any official correspondence will be in writing and signed by TxDOT's Project Manager, as identified in Part A, Section 1, or designee; and

Part B, Section 2 regarding the organization of Qs is hereby revised as follows:

Proposers are required to assemble their QS in the order prescribed and following the outline form contained in this Part.

The title and first paragraph of Part B, Volume 1, Section A(d) regarding references is hereby revised as follows:

(d) Form D

The Proposers shall send a completed Form D to all of the references required for all project experience listed on Forms E-1, E-2 and E-3. Proposers will be responsible for having such references each return completed Form D directly to TxDOT prior to 3:00

p.m. on June 28, 2012. Only the Forms D received prior to such deadline will be used for the Proposers evaluation. For purposes of completing Form D, Proposers may include references from current TxDOT Corpus Christi District personnel other than Lonnie Gregorcyk, James Harris, Paula Sales-Evans, Ernesto de la Garza and Oscar Soliz.

Part B, Volume 1 Appendix, Section C(a) shall regarding references is hereby revised as follows:

- (a) Name of the project, the public owner's contact information (project manager name, phone number, e-mail address), and project number (if any) and dates of work performed on the project. If the owner's project manager is no longer employed by the owner, provide an alternative contact at the owner/agency who played a leadership role for the owner during the dates work was performed on the project and is familiar with the project. TxDOT may elect to use the information provided to verify the experience claimed for an individual. A minimum of three individual projects and references shall be provided for each resume. Resumes may include references from current TxDOT Corpus Christi District personnel other than Lonnie Gregorcyk, James Harris, Paula Sales-Evans, Ernesto de la Garza and Oscar Soliz.
