This notice is to advise the public that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the proposed improvements to United States Highway (US) 377 to reconstruct and widen approximately one mile of US 377 from a two-lane rural section to a four-lane divided urban section with a raised median between Henrietta Creek Road and James Street, and left-turn bays at Crockett, Denton, and Main streets.
