Notice of Availability: Record of Decision Trinity Parkway in Dallas County, Texas

Pursuant to Texas Administrative Code, Title 43, §2.108, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and the North Texas Tollway Authority (NTTA) are advising the public of the availability of the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Record of Decision (ROD) for the proposed construction of the Trinity Parkway in Dallas County, Texas. The project would construct a six-lane, limited access toll road from the I-35E/State Highway (SH) 183 Interchange (northern terminus) to the U.S. Highway 175/SH 310 Interchange (southern terminus), a distance of approximately nine miles.

The primary purpose of the project is to provide a safe and efficient transportation solution to manage traffic congestion and improve safety in the area of the Dallas Central Business District.

The ROD explains the selection of the recommended alternative, and signifies the completion of the environmental review process.
