**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING
PROPOSED WIDENING OF DARRINGTON ROAD
FROM ALBERTON AVENUE TO 200 FEET SOUTH OF LTV ROAD
TOWN OF HORIZON CITY, EL PASO COUNTY, TEXAS

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), in cooperation with the Town of Horizon City, and El Paso County, would like to invite you to participate in a Public Meeting regarding the proposed widening of Darrington Road, from an existing two-lane roadway to a four-lane roadway. The proposed project includes a proposed pond, continuous sidewalks and bike lanes in each direction along Darrington Road within the project limits, and would require approximately five (5) acres of additional right-of-way (ROW) for proposed drainage retention ponds. The project traverses the Town of Horizon City, Texas from Alberton Avenue to 200 feet south of LTV Road, and is approximately 1.3 miles in length. The meeting will be held on Thursday, June 25, 2015 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the Ricardo Estrada Junior High School at 851 Darrington Rd, El Paso, TX 79928.

The purpose of the Public Meeting is to present the proposed project to the interested public. The meeting will be held in an open house format with no formal presentation. Representatives from TxDOT and the project team will be available to answer questions about the proposed project. The public will have the opportunity to learn more about and comment on the project needs, purpose, and identified environmental constraints. Maps showing the proposed project's location and geometric design will be available for viewing at the meeting. This information will also be available for public inspection at the TxDOT El Paso District Office located at 13301 Gateway Boulevard West, El Paso, TX 79928-5410, the Town of Horizon City's Town Hall at 14999 Darrington Road, Horizon City, TX 79928, and the El Paso County Public Works Department at 800 East Overland, Room 407, El Paso, TX 79901.



Written comments from the public regarding this project are welcome and may be accepted for a period of 10 calendar days following the meeting. Written comments may be submitted either in person or by mail to Oswaldo Lopez, E.I.T., at the TxDOT El Paso District Office located at 13301 Gateway Boulevard West, El Paso, TX 79928-5410. Written comments must be postmarked by July 06, 2015.
