




## Notice Affording an Opportunity for a Public Hearing

Loop 375 (Joe Battle Boulevard)  
From US 62/180 (Montana Avenue) to Bob Hope Drive  
El Paso County, Texas  
CSJ: 2552-03-054

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) proposes to widen a 7.8-mile segment of Loop 375 (Joe Battle Boulevard) from United States Highway (US) 62/180 (Montana Avenue) to Bob Hope Drive in El Paso, Texas. The existing Loop 375 roadway is a limited-access facility that forms a partial loop around the City of El Paso. The existing mainlanes within the project limits consist of four 12-foot-wide travel lanes (two in each direction), 10-foot-wide outside shoulders, and a 24-foot-wide inside shoulders.



The proposed project would consist of widening the existing Loop 375 between US 62/180 (Montana Avenue) and Bob Hope Drive. The project would reconstruct the existing roadway's inside shoulders and accommodate one additional 12-foot-wide travel lane in each direction for a total of six travel lanes (three in each direction). Additionally, the proposed project calls for the conversion of the existing northbound outside shoulder to a northbound auxiliary

lane between the Vista Del Sol Drive entrance ramp and the Montwood Avenue exit ramp. No new Right of Way (ROW) or easements are required, and the proposed project would not require any residential or business displacements.

Maps showing the project location and design, environmental document, tentative construction schedule, and other information relative to the project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT's El Paso District Office located at 13301 Gateway West, El Paso, Texas 79928.

Any interested party may request a public hearing covering the social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed location and design for this project.
