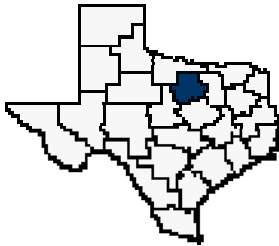




## DISTRICT PROFILE

### MAJOR PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- North Tarrant Express I-35W – rebuild and widen - \$1.6 billion
- Midtown Express (SH 183) – rebuild and widen - \$850 million
- SH 360 South – toll road - \$340 million
- SH 360/I-30 Interchange - \$233 million
- Trinity River Vision - bridges - \$66 million
- SH 121/360 Interchange - \$61 million
- SH 199 – add mainlanes and bridges - \$46.3 million

### PLANNED MAJOR PROJECTS:

- I-820 East Loop – rebuild and widen - \$200 million (2018)
- North Tarrant Express I-35W North of US 81/287 – rebuild and widen - \$700 million (2018)
- SH 121 Interchanges at I-635 and FM 2499 - \$370 million (2018)

**MAINTENANCE:** We spend approximately \$100 million annually for preventative, routine and rehabilitative maintenance.

**SAFETY:** Our current and upcoming safety projects include 47 miles of added shoulders along farm-to-market roads in Hood, Johnson, Tarrant and Wise Counties.
