



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING
IH 20 AT CENTER POINT ROAD INTERCHANGE AND FRONTAGE ROADS
FROM E. BANKHEAD TO LAKESHORE DRIVE**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and Parker County will hold a Public Meeting to discuss the proposed IH 20 – Center Point Road Interchange improvements in the City of Hudson Oaks and Weatherford, Parker County, Texas. The purpose of the meeting is to offer an opportunity to discuss and make comments on the proposed interchange, local access ramp and frontage road improvements extending from E. Bankhead to Lakeshore Drive. The Public Meeting will be an open house format, allowing visitors to come and go at their own availability, and will be held on:

The project is needed to complete the interchange and provide access for all traffic movements between IH 20 and Center Point Road and provide one-way frontage roads extending between E. Bankhead and Lakeshore Drive. Congestion mitigation for Parker County residents would be provided through full access to IH 20 at Center Point Road that would be an alternate IH 20 connection on the east side of Weatherford.

Layouts reflecting the proposed Build Alternative will be displayed at the Public Meeting. The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S. Code Section 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding executed by the Federal Highway Administration and TxDOT, dated December 16, 2014.
