



**TxDOT NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING AND NOTICE OF FLOODPLAIN ENCROACHMENT
FOR THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF EAST-WEST CONNECTOR ROADWAY FROM STATE
HIGHWAY (SH) 360 AT EAST OF HARWOOD ROAD TO INTERNATIONAL PARKWAY AT RENTAL
CAR DRIVE**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Fort Worth District, in cooperation with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), will conduct a Public Meeting on Thursday, July 30, 2015 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. in the Community Room at the Mary Lib Saleh Eules Public Library, 201 North Ector Drive, Eules, Texas, 76039. The purpose of the meeting is to offer an opportunity for the public to discuss and make comments regarding proposed construction of a 1.27-mile, four-lane roadway from State Highway (SH) 360 at East of Harwood Road to International Parkway at Rental Car Drive on DFW Airport property. Maps of the project area and other displays will be available for review and comment, and TxDOT staff will be available to answer questions. The Public Meeting will be an open-house format, allowing visitors to come and go at their availability.

The purpose of the proposed project is:

- To complete a corridor between SH 161/President George Bush Turnpike (PGBT) and SH 360 that promotes connectivity and regional mobility for the east-west travel patterns near the southern side of DFW Airport and
- To provide an additional access point for surface transportation entering and leaving DFW Airport property.


The proposed project is currently in the schematic design phase, and an environmental assessment is underway. The proposed project is needed to enhance mobility and provide an alternate parallel east-west route for the congested SH 183. Approximately 22 acres of new right-of-way (ROW) on DFW Airport property and 0.7 acre of existing TxDOT ROW would be required for the proposed project.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S. Code Section 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding executed by the Federal Highway Administration and TxDOT, dated December 16, 2014.

Per Executive Order 11988, Floodplain Management, and the U.S. Department of Transportation Order 5650.2, Floodplain Management and Protection, TxDOT and FAA have determined the proposed action is located within the 100-year floodplain and will be identifying and evaluating practicable alternatives to locating the action in the floodplain and will be evaluating the potential impacts on the floodplain.

Written comments from the public regarding this project are requested through August 10, 2015 and will become part of the project documentation. Written comments may be submitted during the open house or either in person or by mail to the Texas Department of Transportation, Attention: Mr. Brian R. Barth, P.E., District Engineer, 2501 SW Loop 820, Fort Worth, Texas 76133.

All interested persons are invited to attend.
