SH 121 in Johnson County cleared by FHWA

The Fort Worth District office of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) announced that the Federal Highway Administration has issued a finding of no significant impact on the environment assessment for proposed construction on SH 121 from U.S. 67 in Cleburne to FM 1187 in south Tarrant County.

This finding completes the environmental and public involvement requirements for this project and allows TxDOT to continue with the development of this highway that will help accommodate current and expected growth in the area.

The proposed project would ultimately be constructed as a controlled-access, four-lane divided toll facility for approximately 14 miles from U.S. 67 to FM 1187 at an estimated cost of \$144 million. At this time, the project is only funded to construct a two-lane highway at an estimated cost of \$34 million. Construction could begin as soon as 2006.
