

Description of Meeting Held

Continuing the public involvement program in the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) held an open-house meeting on October 21, 2008 from 6:00 to 8:00 pm in Richmond, Fort Bend County, Texas.

The meeting was announced and advertised through a variety of methods. At least thirty days prior to the meeting, TxDOT engaged in an extensive effort to announce the meetings through mailings and published advertisements. A copy of the Public Notice (Appendix A) announcing the meeting time, location and purpose was mailed to a list (Appendix B) of landowners with property adjacent to the existing right-of-way (ROW) and citizens who may be directly affected by changes in access. Advertisements (Appendix A) were published in newspapers with local and city-wide circulation, including the *Houston Chronicle*, the *Houston Chronicle's La Voz* (Spanish paper), and the Houston Community Newspapers' *Fort Bend / Southwest Sun*.

At the meeting, the public signed in (Appendix C) and each person was provided with a blank pre-addressed comment form. Sign-in sheets indicate that seventeen (17) citizens and one (1) public official attended the meeting; two (2) additional citizens attended but chose not to sign-in. All comments were submitted during the meeting (i.e., none was mailed). The public was encouraged to visit information stations for information on project design and environmental

constraints. Several engineers and environmental professionals were available at each station to provide information and answer questions (Appendices D and E).

Summary of Comments

By the conclusion of the comment period on November 4, 2008, TxDOT received eight comments: one was e-mailed, and seven were submitted on comment forms at the Public Meeting. Of these seven, five contained written comments; two indicated no comment (Appendix F). Each comment or letter received was counted as one respondent.

The written comments received addressed the following issues:

- Congestion during construction
- Other TxDOT projects not complete, yet proposing another
- Effects of ROW acquisition on utility access
- Scheduling of meetings during other local meetings








Existing US 90A Typical Section




Proposed Interim US 90A Typical Section at Grade Separation




Proposed Ultimate US 90A Typical Section at Grade Separation


Proposed Interim US 90A Typical Section East End




**Proposed Ultimate US 90A Typical Section


