PUBLIC MEETING SUMMARY

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), Houston District conducted a Public Meeting concerning the proposed IH 10 Managed Lanes project from SH 6 to FM 359 in Harris, Fort Bend and Waller Counties, Texas. The meeting was held on January 13, 2009 in the cafeteria at Katy High School located at 6331 Highway Boulevard in Katy, Texas 77494. The proposed project consists of the addition of four managed lanes and the extension of frontage roads (in sections). The total length of the project is approximately 18.2 miles. The proposed project would require approximately 51 acres of additional right-of-way, which would result in seven business displacements.

The public meeting was held from approximately 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. in an open house format to give citizens an opportunity to view all of the various exhibits that were on display at the meeting and to discuss and ask questions concerning the proposed project with project staff members. The exhibits included 1) the project need and purpose, 2) an explanation of managed lanes, 3) an environmental constraints map, and 4) two copies of the design schematic, which included typical sections.

A registration table was located at the entrance of the cafeteria where the meeting was conducted. The registration table contained sign in sheets for attendees to register, Public Meeting Comment Forms for attendees to share their thoughts regarding the proposed project, and Public Meeting Programs. The Public Meeting Programs contained a brief description and purpose of the proposed project, typical sections of the project, and the TxDOT mailing address and website address for post-meeting submittal of written comments (see **Appendix B**). Additionally, TxDOT right-of-way personnel were located at another table, where they answered individual questions and made available to attendees copies of the State Purchase of Right-of-Way and Relocation Assistance booklets. The registration attendance totaled 61 from the general public and three elected officials (see **Appendix C**). Photographs of exhibits presented at the meeting, the registration table, the written comment station, and right-of-way station are included in **Appendix D**.

Public Comments

Several people asked questions or made comments. A few of the commenter's expressed multiple concerns. All verbal questions and comments were immediately responded to at the meeting. Fourteen Public Meeting Comment Forms were submitted at the public meeting; however, three of those forms contained no questions or comments. Three additional comment forms were submitted by mail and six comments were submitted via e-mail by the deadline of December 23, 2009. Due to the overlap and repetition in many comments, similar comments were consolidated and paraphrased to reduce duplication. As a result, the comments that appear in this report are often not the precise words found in the commenter's written comment. This has been done to minimize repetition or duplication of similar comments that elicited a common response and in no way was intended to obscure the substance of a comment. Copies of all original written comments, letters and comment forms from the public meeting are appended to this report (**Appendix E**) and would be available for public inspection at the TxDOT Houston District Office located at 7600 Washington Avenue in Houston between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm weekdays. A summary of the questions/comments received and responses are shown below:

Six similar comments received – Paraphrased Comments 1-6: At the I-10 and FM 359 intersection there needs to be easy access to 10th Street. The median would prevent easy access to residential homes at this location. Cars from the north and west won't be able to turn into 10th. Cars coming off of 10th won't be able to turn south on FM 359.

Response: Due to the access to the water treatment plant, 10th street can not be closed and realignment of the facility would have severe impacts to the properties in the area.

Comment 7: We are more concerned with drainage issues when construction begins on FM 359 in Brookshire. With heavy rains that area holds plenty water and would like TxDOT to provide detailed plans with improved drainage within that area.

Response: FM 359 is a separate project; however, we will forward your concerns to the FM 359 Project Manager.

Comment 8: All for improvements to IH-10.

Response: Comment noted.

Comment 9: We need extension of managed lanes west of SH 6. Good project. Keep up the good work.

Response: Comment noted.

Comment 10: No more toll roads!!!! Why have 4 extra lanes that cannot be used on the weekends? If the main lanes work the toll road won't generate the kind of money they want. If you want to put a toll road in make it one with wheels – mass transit.

Response: Due to funding issues, toll roads have become a viable alternative for funding highway projects. The “toll roads” will actually be managed lanes, which will accommodate toll traffic as well as high-occupancy vehicles (HOV), two or more occupants, traffic. The managed lanes will operate will operate 24 hours a day and 7 days a week once operations begin.

Comment 11: Initially, I will acknowledge the excellent efforts of TxDOT to improve mass transportation into and out of the City of Houston. The proposition appears to have covered all grounds in constructing a safe and more efficient transit. My compliments to that note. Unfortunately, I have considerable concern to not only the proposed construction, but as well our current highway system. Primarily, the cost of this construction will be considerable to budget, meaning a project of this size requires significant funding. The direction of the proposed funds should be focused on solving more local/residential congestion rather than areas of less population. The proposed project will seize significant amounts of property from private land owners and small business. The numerous super elevations will require many man hours and financial cost, specifically the Pin Oak superelevation. In addition, did taxpayers not just finish funding for the extensive I10 reconstruction? And now they want to propose more. The flaws on our current highway system, in specific the Katy Tollway/HOV Lanes should be focused into the prospective. Our nation, state, and local economies need considerable revision before the 2012 begin date. Overall the project seems to have the future in mind, yet my opinion and most relevant comment would be to acknowledge our current financial and congestion issues. Thank you, good job, and good luck!

Response: Thank you for your comment.

Comment 12: I attended the January 13, 2009 public meeting and wish to make the following comments with regard to the IH 10 Managed Lane Project: As someone who lives and works along the IH 10 corridor, I support the project and its early implementation. The project is very important to the mobility of west Houston and all efforts to expedite it should be undertaken.

Response: Comment noted.

Comment 13: Please go ahead extending the toll road from Hwy 6 to FM 359. Thanks.

Response: Comment noted.

Comment 14: You can't possibly be thinking of extending the managed lanes into Katy. This is the dumbest setup for a freeway that we've ever seen. The main thing you've managed to do with this setup in Houston is to waste some of the most expensive and critical real estate in the city. You're going to get a great deal of opposition on this, including from us.

Response: Comment noted.

Comment 15: Regarding the proposal to extend I-10 toll lanes to FM 359 in Waller County: There is absolutely no reason to extend toll lanes further than they already are on I-10. In fact, the 2 existing toll lanes on each side should be reduced to 1 lane to help the flow of rush hour traffic which help reduce the pollutants being entered into the atmosphere by cars sitting in traffic for an hour or longer.

Response: The reason that there are two managed lanes in each direction is safety. This allows for traffic to safely pass vehicles which break down. It also allows faster vehicles to pass slower vehicles, thus reducing congestion and pollution.

Comment 16: I would like to be kept informed as to future meetings, mailings, developments. We'd very much like to see a definite plan as to what land frontage will be used – what time-frame is involved, etc.

Response: Your name has been added to the mailing list for future meetings. A schematic plan of the proposed project are on file and available for viewing at the district project development office at 7600 Washington Avenue, Houston, Texas 77007. The proposed project will acquire approximately 51 acres of additional right-of-way and the schematic shows the locations of the additional right-of-way. Construction for the proposed project is scheduled to begin in 2012.

Comment 17: Stop the privatization of our public transportation assets in their tracks now, lest up-front payments sate the political calls for the “miracle cure” to our transportation needs this year and saddle us for 49 more years and burden generations to come with a deal that served the private sector not the public sector. Such a transportation privatization policy is recklessly leveraging our future! Raise the gas tax, index it to inflation and use the bonding tools available to fund our roads. In some rare instances, county (public) toll road authorities might serve, as well, with commissioners accountable to the citizenry using the toll funds within the county and retiring/reducing the tolls whenever possible. Keep our public transportation assets in the public treasury.

Response: Thank you for your comment. The management of the managed lanes has yet to be determined.

Comment 18: I attended a public meeting Tuesday, January 12, 2009 at Katy High School. The meeting was about the changes to I-10 going west through Brookshire. I was told that Otto Marsh would be the person to contact for map request for this project. Can I get segments of the map?

Response: An open records request can be sent to Otto Marsh at omaresh@dot.state.tx.us.

Comment 19: We feel like it is a real travesty that TxDOT does not consider the public's best interest in this type of project. You are proposing to spend millions of taxpayers' money tearing down a perfectly good overpass that is only 2 to 3 years old at Pin Oak and IH-10. Also, building a roadway-on-off at Prairie Parkway which at this time provides no immediate benefit (provides benefit to a few select landowners). It would make sense to have a service

road off the north side of IH-10 from FM 1463 to Pederson Road. This would be less than one mile of construction as currently proposed. This would greatly affect the traffic pattern on the west side of Katy and would help the traffic circulation for all the citizens of Katy and the west side area. There is currently a tremendous amount of traffic in this west side area. Also, it is a real concern of mine as a real estate broker trying to sell the Bartlett 37 acre tract on the south side of IH-10. I would like to make sure that the 2 entrances on this property of the IH-10 service road remain intact after the proposed taking and new on-off-ramps for Prairie Parkway are established.

Response: It has always been TxDOT's plan to reconstruct the IH 10/Pin Oak bridge. The schematic for the IH 10 reconstruction project includes the replacement of the bridge. The existing bridge, which was built by the developers of Katy Mills was meant to be an interim condition. The proposed design has IH 10 going over Pin Oak. This design will improve circulation in the area and facilitate access to IH 10.

The Prairie Parkway is still in the conceptual stage. No determination of the route and intersection with IH 10 has been made, therefore, no ramping has been proposed for this proposed road.

At this time, we don't know where the "Bartlett 37 acre tract" is located, and thus cannot reply to that comment.

There is a frontage road between FM 1463 and Pederson on the south side. That frontage road would be reconstructed. A frontage road is proposed between FM 1463 and Cane Island Parkway on the north side. TxDOT owns the right-of-access on the north side between Cane Island Parkway and Pederson Road, and has no plans to construct a frontage road.

Comment 20: When is the water treatment on I-10 near FM 359 removed in order to expand lanes on I-10 and frontage roads?

Response: The amount of ROW required in that area is small enough that there are no displacements required. The water treatment plant would not have to be moved for this project.




Exhibit showing the design schematic for the eastern portion of the project


