



FM 1463 WIDENING

PUBLIC MEETING – FEBRUARY 26, 2015

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct a public meeting to present proposed roadway improvements for FM 1463 from IH 10 (W) to FM 1093 Fort Bend County, Texas. The meeting will be held on February 26, 2015, in the Shafer Elementary School cafeteria at 5150 Ranch Point Drive, Katy, Texas 77494. The meeting will be held in an open house format from 5:30 PM to 7:30 PM.

The purpose of the meeting is to gather public input on the proposed roadway improvement project. The proposed project would widen and improve the existing roadway from two lanes to four lanes with a raised median. Approximately 20 acres of additional right-of-way would be needed for the proposed improvements but no displacements are anticipated. The project length is 6.7 miles.

Exhibits showing aerial photography and schematic plans of the proposed project corridor will be presented at the meeting. Representatives from TxDOT and their study team will be available to answer individual questions. Public comments are encouraged. The schematic plan is on file and available for review at the TxDOT Houston District Office at 7600 Washington Avenue, Houston, Texas 77007 and at the Fort Bend Area office located at 4235 SH 36 South, Rosenberg, TX 77471. TxDOT offices are open Monday through Friday, from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, excluding state holidays.

All interested persons are invited to attend this public meeting. Persons interested in attending the public meeting who have special communication or accommodation needs are encouraged to contact the TxDOT Public Information Office at 713-802-5072 at least two working days prior to the meeting. Since the public meeting will be conducted in English, any requests for language interpreters or other special communication needs should also be made at least two working days prior to the public meeting. TxDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs.

Written comments related to the proposed project may be submitted at the meeting or mailed to the Director of Project Development, Texas Department of Transportation, P.O. Box 1386, Houston, Texas 77251-1386, on or before March 12, 2015. Comments also may be emailed on or before March 12, 2015, to HOU-PIOWebMail@TxDOT.gov. A public meeting summary report will be available on the TxDOT website in the Spring of 2015.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 16, 2014, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.
