



**Notice of Public Meeting**  
**Grand Parkway (SH 99): from US 59N to I-10E (Segments H & I-1)**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and The Grand Parkway Association (GPA) will hold a meeting to present proposed design modifications to the Grand Parkway, State Highway 99, from U.S. Highway 59 North/I-69 to I-10 East (Segments H & I-1). The meeting will be held Tuesday, June 9, 2015 at Dayton Community Center, 801 South Cleveland Street, Dayton, Texas 77535 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.

Since the Federal Highway Administration issued a Record of Decision on June 24, 2014 for this segment of Grand Parkway, continuing project development efforts have identified the need for shifts in the Selected Alternative. These minor shifts in alignment are in response to public comments and private landowners' requests in the proposed project area and are based on multiple meetings with local officials, landowners and members of the public. To document and analyze the proposed modifications, TxDOT has developed a re-evaluation of the Final Environmental Impact Statement.

TxDOT is proposing alignment shifts in the vicinity of the Luce Bayou crossing, near the US 90 crossing, near the ExxonMobil Plant in Mont Belvieu, and along the existing canal near SH 146 and FM 565. These proposed modifications were previously presented to affected property owners at a Meeting with Affected Property Owners (MAPO) held on February 24, 2015, and at a meeting with Liberty County Commissioner's Court held on March 17, 2015. The purpose of this meeting is to present to the public the proposed design modifications that were previously presented at the MAPO meeting and to Liberty County Commissioner's Court and to receive public comment. Other than the proposed alignment shifts presented at the two meetings noted above, no additional design modifications for Segments H and I-1 are currently under consideration.

Maps showing the proposed project location and design drawings will be available for review at the Public Meeting. This information will also be available by appointment for review Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at the TxDOT Houston District Office located at 7600 Washington Avenue, Houston, Texas 77007 and also available on the Grand Parkway website: [www.grandpky.com](http://www.grandpky.com).

Persons interested in attending this meeting who have special communication and/or accommodation needs are encouraged to contact TxDOT Houston District Public Information Office at (713) 802-5000 at least two working days prior to the meeting. Because this meeting will be conducted in English, any request for language interpreters or other special communication needs should also be made at least two working days prior to the meeting with affected property owners. TxDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs.

Written comments from the public regarding this project are requested and may be presented for a period of 10 business days following the meeting. Written comments may be submitted either in person or by mail to the TxDOT District Office, Director of Project Development, P.O. Box 1386, Houston, Texas 77251. Written comments must be postmarked or emailed to [houstonpiwebmail@txdot.gov](mailto:houstonpiwebmail@txdot.gov) by June 23, 2015, to be included in the Public Meeting Summary.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 16, 2014, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.
