



PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

Roadway Improvements
FM 529 at SH 6
Harris County, Texas

The Houston District of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct a public meeting for the proposed improvements for the intersection at State Highway (SH) 6 and Farm to Market (FM) 529, Harris County, Texas. The meeting will be held on Tuesday June 18, 2013 at the Langham Creek High School campus which is located at 17610 FM 529 Houston, Texas 77095. The meeting will be an open house format from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Project personnel will be present to answer questions regarding the proposed project at the open house.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed improvements. The proposed improvements consist of improved approach geometrics to include additional turning lanes, an additional through lane on SH 6, and improved signalization. The proposed project would acquire 5.69 acres from 12 parcels within the proposed right-of-way. The proposed project is located in Harris County, approximately 15 miles west of downtown Houston, Texas, and approximately four miles north of IH-10.

All interested citizens are invited to attend, to express their views, and to discuss the project with TxDOT representatives. Those interested in attending who have special communication or accommodation needs are encouraged to contact the TxDOT Public Information Officer at (713) 802-5072 at least two working days prior to the date of the meeting.

Maps showing the project location and design, the environmental documentation, tentative construction schedules, and other information relative to the project are on file and available for review at the TxDOT Houston District Office located at 7600 Washington Ave, Houston, TX 77007. TxDOT offices are open Monday through Friday, from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, excluding state holidays. The public meeting will be conducted in English. Request for language interpreters or other special communication needs should also be made at least two days prior to the date of the public meeting. TxDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs.
