



NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING CRABB RIVER ROAD (FM 2759/FM 762)

Fort Bend County and Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), Houston District, will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed improvements to Crabb River Road (FM 2759/FM 762), Fort Bend County, Texas. The meeting will be held on Thursday, November 5, 2015, at the George Ranch High School Cafeteria, 8181 FM 762, Richmond, TX 77469. The meeting will be held in an open house format from 5:30PM to 7:30PM. No formal presentation will be made.

The purpose of the Public Meeting is to present the proposed project to the public and receive comments. The project limits extend from approximately 0.25 miles south of Sansbury Boulevard to approximately 500 feet south of the Lamar Consolidated Independent School District Complex located on FM 762, a total distance of approximately 2.9 miles. The proposed improvements would be implemented in two phases. Phase I would widen the existing Crabb River Road (FM 2759/FM 762) roadway to a 4-lane divided raised median roadway. Phase II would include a grade separation (overpass) at BNSF Railroad intersection at the BNSF Railroad and Thompsons Road (FM 762/FM 2759). The purpose of the project is to provide additional capacity, enhance safety, and improve access and connectivity.

The proposed project would require additional right-of-way (ROW) and would potentially result in displacements. Property owners within the proposed limits are encouraged to participate in this public meeting and to receive information. The Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 and its amendments provide rules, policies, and procedures that govern the relocation of individuals and businesses without discrimination that may be displaced as a result of publicly funded construction ROW acquisition. Right-of-Way personnel from Fort Bend County will be available for questions and provide information regarding the ROW acquisition process at the meeting.

Maps showing the proposed project's location and design drawings will be available for review at the Public Meeting. This information will also be available by appointment for review Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00AM and 5:00PM, excluding state holidays, at the TxDOT Houston District Office, located at 7600 Washington Avenue, Houston, Texas 77007, and at TxDOT's Southeast Houston Area Office, located at 702 FM 1959, Houston, Texas 77034. All interested citizens are invited to attend this public meeting. Written comments from the public regarding this project are requested and may be presented for a period of 10 business days following the meeting. Written comments may be submitted either in person or by mail to the TxDOT District Office, Director of Project Development, PO Box 1386, Houston, TX 77251. Written comments must be postmarked or emailed to hou-piowebmail@txdot.gov by November 19, 2015, to be included in the Public Meeting Summary.

The Public Meeting will be conducted in English. Persons interested in attending the meeting who have special communication or accommodation needs, or need an interpreter, are encouraged to



contact the TxDOT District Public Information Officer at TxDOT (713) 802-5076. Requests should be made at least two working days prior to the public meeting. Every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate these needs.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 16, 2014, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.
