Proposed access improvements to State Highway (SH) 105, from IH-45 to FM 2854 in Montgomery County.



Purpose

- Provide short-, medium- and long-term improvements to SH 105 as part of an access management study effort
- Reduce crashes, improve mobility and support existing and future development
- Provide vehicular access to land development that preserves safety and efficiency

Benefits

- Improve safety through reduced crashes
- Improve traffic operations
- Reduce congestion by improving travel time
- Improve accessibility by promoting safer travel to land development
- Provide multi-modal improvements by supporting safer alternatives for different modes of travel

Proposed Improvements

- Left and dual left-turns
- Right-turn (deceleration) lanes
- Raised and channelized medians
- Traffic signal modifications
- Signal timing and phasing improvements
- Sidewalk connections
- ADA compliant curb ramps
- Improved pedestrian signals
- Improved shoulders
- Bicycle accommodations
