



**PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE**  
**Roadway Improvements**  
**SH 146: BS 146E to Ferry Road**  
**Harris County, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct a public meeting for proposed improvements to SH 146 from Business 146 to Ferry Road in Baytown, Harris County, Texas. The meeting will be conducted on November 17, 2010, at the Stephen F. Austin Elementary School campus, which is located at 3022 Massey-Tompkins Road, Baytown, Texas 77521. The meeting format will be an open house from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Project personnel will be present to answer questions regarding the proposed project at the open house.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed improvements. The proposed project consists of improvement of SH 146 through the construction of a new four-lane divided roadway from SH 146, east of BS 146E to northeast of Ferry Road. The four main lanes are within the existing right-of-way (ROW) to provide a continuous four-lane typical freeway section throughout the project limits. The proposed project also includes a grade-separated intersection at SH 146 and North Alexander Drive. The total project length is approximately 0.87 miles or 4,594 feet. The project would not require the acquisition of new ROW. There would be no displacements of residences or commercial structures.

The purpose of the proposed project is to improve capacity and provide a continuous roadway between BS 146E and northeast of Ferry Road in order to accommodate existing traffic, future growth of the region, improve safety, and to improve connectivity. Public comments regarding the proposed roadway construction will be solicited at this meeting.

All interested citizens are invited to attend, to express their views, and discuss the project with TxDOT representatives. Those interested in attending who have special communication or accommodation needs are encouraged to contact the TxDOT District Public Information Officer at (713) 802-5072 at least two working days prior to the date of the meeting. TxDOT offices are open Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding state holidays. The public meeting will be conducted in English. Requests for language interpreters or other special communication needs should also be made at least two days prior to the date of the public meeting. TxDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs.
