



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct a public hearing to discuss the proposed reconstruction of State Highway (SH) 146 From Red Bluff to FM 518 in Harris and Galveston Counties, Texas. The public hearing will be held as follows:

The purpose of this hearing is to present the proposed design alternative and gather public input regarding the proposed reconstruction of the facility. The proposed project consists of reconstructing the existing four-lane facility to a six to twelve-lane facility in order to improve mobility and congestion. This project, as proposed, would require approximately 34.28 acres of additional right-of-way.

The meeting will be structured in an open house format from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., with a formal hearing beginning at 6:30 p.m. Exhibits will be displayed for viewing from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. All interested persons are invited to attend this public hearing. Representatives from TxDOT and the study team will be available to answer individual questions during the open house portion. Public comments are encouraged. Forms will be available to submit written comments at the meeting, or may be mailed to the Director of Project Development, Texas Department of Transportation, P.O. Box 1386, Houston, Texas 77251-1386. All mailed comments must be postmarked by February 10, 2012.
