



US 59/SL 224 Open House Summary and Comment/ Response Report

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 16, 2014, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.

Open House Summary

On September 3, 2015, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) held an Open House at the Nacogdoches County Exposition and Civit Center in Nacogdoches, Texas from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. to present an updated project alignment, explain where the project was in the project development process, answer questions and gather local citizen input.

Open House Outreach

The Lufkin District employed eight outreach methods to inform and invite the public to attend the September 3, 2015 public meeting. Efforts were made to reach the Limited English Proficiency (LEP) populations by translating flyers and mailings and advertising in a Spanish language newspaper, as well as offering interpretation at the Open House. Copies of the outreach methods are included in **Attachment A**.

Methods

- Display Ads - advertisements were published in The Daily Sentinel on August 30, 2015 and September 2, 2015; and in Spanish in La Lengua on September 2, 2015.
- News Release - a story describing the proposed project was published on August 27, 2015 announcing the open house date.
- Fliers - fliers were left at apartments and local businesses near the project area (i.e. laundromat, grocery store, drug store, restaurants) for patrons to take.
- Letters to Elected Officials and Affected Property Owners - Letters were mailed to elected officials and area representatives and affected property owners on August 7, 2015.
- Website - TxDOT website included information on the date, time, location and purpose, as well as the meeting materials including exhibit materials, comment forms, and project maps.
- Social Media Information - The Open House was promoted through TxDOT Twitter and Facebook accounts.
- Electronic Changeable Message Signs - TxDOT's electronic message boards were placed on US 59 northbound south of the loop, and on SL 224 southbound near the Expo Center. Signs were placed at least one week prior to the meeting.

Members of the public who attended the meeting were asked to indicate to us how they heard about the meeting when signing in. Not all attendees indicated a method and some indicated more than one. Results are shown in Table 1.

Media Coverage

Website Outreach

Information was available through numerous web-based outlets. Analyses of the web data were performed using Adobe Marketing Cloud.

Open House Format and Results

The meeting was come and go format allowing the public to not only view exhibit boards and schematic drawings but also speak to TxDOT staff one on one regarding the proposed project from 4:00 to 7:00 pm.

Registration and Handouts

Upon arrival, attendees were asked to sign in and were offered a set of handouts which included a double-sided Fact Sheet with the information provided on the information boards, and Comment Form. Approximately 308 members of the public and 10 elected official/representatives signed in at the Open House (**see Attachment C**).

Exhibits and Displays

Nine project-specific informational boards were displayed for the public to view. The informational boards included: a meeting overview board, Project Purpose and Need, Project Location, Project Background, Phase I Information, Phase II Information, Proposed Changes to Phase II, Project Timeline, and a board providing mechanisms to stay informed. In addition, more general informational boards about I-69 were displayed (**Attachment D**). These displays included layouts and maps of the project area. A 3-d “fly through” rendering was played on a loop to help better visualize the project concept.

Comments and Responses

The public was invited to submit comments on the project. Attendees had the option of leaving their completed comment forms in the drop boxes provided or submitting verbal comment to the available court reporter. A total of 26 comment forms were completed, and four attendees provided verbal comments with the court reporter. Each comment was read and summarized in a comment response matrix (**see Attachment E**).

LUFKIN – The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will host an Open House concerning the US 59/State Loop 224 South Interchange (Future I-69) project from 4-7 p.m. September 3, 2015 at the Nacogdoches County Exposition and Civic Center.

The US 59/State Loop 224 South Interchange project is dedicated to improving safety and mobility from south of Spradley Street on US 59 to the intersection of SH 7 West and State Loop 224. The intersection project was developed to be constructed in two phases. Phase I, currently under construction, was awarded to Webber Construction for \$14 million and is scheduled for completion in 2017. Phase I includes raised medians, a widened roadway, sidewalks, and reconfiguration of the US 59/State Loop 224 South intersection.

Phase II involves the construction of new US 59 main lanes, overpasses at Spradley Street and Business 59 and frontage roads on State Loop 224. Although no construction funding has been identified for Phase II, TxDOT proposes to use the \$6 million that was allocated for I-69 project development in Nacogdoches County to begin purchasing right of way.

With support from local officials and the public, TxDOT is revising project plans to bring the roadway up to Interstate standards. TxDOT officials will be on hand to display updated layouts, answer questions and hear public comments in a come-and-go style format.



TxDOT invites Nacogdoches to discuss 'Future I-69 Project' updates

NACOGDOCHES COUNTY, TX (KTRE) - Nacogdoches residents and businesses gathered at the County Expo Center to catch up with big changes going on in their community. The US 59/State Loop 224 South Interchange, part of the Interstate 69 project is well underway.

Traveling to and from Nacogdoches recently, you might have noticed the road work zones.

"It's a nightmare!" said Pam Stokes, a Nacogdoches resident.

It's congested, but it's all for a greater cause. TxDOT invited the community to an open house Thursday night to discuss the US 59/State Loop 224 South Interchange project.

"We are wanting to bring to the public the changes that we have made since the original schematic that we had approved since 2011," said Jennifer Adams, the I-69 Project Manager.

Business owners and residents, some reminiscent on the small road that used to be 59 back in the day, gathered with TxDOT officials to discuss layouts and answer questions.

"I think in general, it's been pretty positive. I think a lot of people in the community want this project. I think it will be helpful," Adams said.

"I think that it will bring growth to the community which we need. I think it's important for our businesses in general," Stokes said.

Maps and virtual models of the finished project were on display.

"Everyone tonight has been interested in seeing what the changes were and how they would affect their properties," Adams said.

"One of the designated routes was right through our property, so I was really happy when they moved it back to 59!" Stokes said.

Once Phase I is complete, the US 59 and Loop 224 intersection will have sidewalks, raised medians, and a widened roadway. Those at open house say the only con is the traffic they are having right now.

"The traffic situations something we will all have to handle it for a little while," Stokes said.

Phase II of the project, which would involve construction of new US 59 lanes, overpasses at Spradley Street, and frontage roads on State Loop 224, would ease the bumper to bumper according to TxDOT.

"Phase II, which is what we are actually here to talk about, will be the direct connector. That should alleviate some of the congestion at business 59," Adams said.

Phase two has not yet been funded, but it is still in the works.

"We are working on getting the reevaluation approved and the new updates to the schematic approved," Adams said.

Until then, completion of phase one is approaching.

"Right now that's kind of where we're at!" Adams said.

"I'm looking forward to when they get the loop completed so we don't have that back up in the traffic," Stokes said.

The Phase I section of the "Future I-69" Project should be done by Spring 2017.





 - Upon environmental clearance and design approval, TxDOT proposes to use \$6 million allocated for I-69 project development in Nacogdoches County to begin acquiring right-of-way



Proposed Changes to Phase II

- Extended project farther south to start near Old Lufkin Rd.
- Remove access and add cul-de-sac on Old Lufkin Rd. south of Nacogdoches
- Shifted proposed main lanes to the east
- Added sidewalks along frontage roads between BU 59 and SH 7
- Revised ramp configuration at SH 7 to include both entrance and exit ramps
- Changes to proposed right-of-way lines in various locations






Status of I-69 in the U.S.

Along with the ROW change coming closer to my residence and the overpass being proposed for the exit to State Highway 7 from Loop 224, the noise can be expected to increase. The new ROW will be closer to my residence. Over the years, the noise levels have increased by an unknown amount due to lack of monitoring with instruments. With the elevated structure in the vicinity, the normal buffers to the noise will no longer be in place, allowing more noise to our neighborhood. The buy-out of the residences along Loop 224 exit to State Highway 7 will remove some noise attenuators.

I am requesting some sort of noise "wall" be installed to dampen the noise from the future roadway(s).

Should the noise "wall" not be economically feasible, my neighbors and I would like some trees planted that would assist in dampening the noise.

Secondary to the noise, such wall or trees would assist in keeping vehicles involved in motor vehicle crashes from ending up near our residences.


