
The Proposed Improvements of Parkway Drive (U.S. 82) In Lubbock

TUESDAY, March 24, 2015 at p.m.

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will host a public meeting at 6:00 p.m., on Tuesday, March 24, 2015 at Alderson Elementary Auditorium, 219 Walnut Avenue in Lubbock, Texas to present the proposed plans to make improvements to Parkway Drive. The project limits begin at MLK Boulevard and extends east approximately 0.62 miles to Cherry Avenue.

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the need for improvements which will include removal of the frontage roads along the south side of Parkway Drive, improvements to the frontage road areas on the north side of Parkway Drive, and the addition of a center turn-lane. These proposed improvements will eliminate conflict and improve safety along this segment of Parkway Drive. This project will not require the acquisition of additional right-of-way. All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting and express their views on this highway proposal.

Since the public meeting will be conducted in English, requests for language interpreters or other special communication needs should also be made at least three days prior to public meeting. TxDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs.
