



DISTRICT PROFILE

The Laredo District plans, designs, builds, operates and maintains the state transportation system in its counties. The district primarily conducts asset preservation and mobility projects to ensure the safety of the traveling public. The Laredo District experiences varying weather conditions to include extreme heat, which result in varying challenges for maintenance crews and designers in order to maintain district assets and assure the safety of the traveling public year-round.

MAJOR PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- State Loop 20 over KCS Railroad: new frontage roads and widening of existing bridge (Webb County) – \$25 million
- US 277 Widening to 5-lane urban from US 57 to SL 480 in Eagle Pass (Maverick Co.) - \$19 million
- US 277 Super 2 passing lanes between Eagle Pass (Maverick Co.) and Del Rio (Val Verde Co.) - \$20.8 million
- US 59 main lanes (SL 20@IH 35) (Webb County) – \$25.5 million

PLANNED MAJOR PROJECTS:

- IH 35 Widening of Main Lanes and Rail Road Grade Separation (North of Shiloh Road) (Webb County) - \$54 million
- IH 35 Direct Connector Interchange (IH35 @ US 59/Loop 20) (Webb County) - \$30 million
- US 83 Roadway Rehabilitation from Dimmit County Line to 16 Miles South (Webb County) - \$58 million
- US 83 Roadway Rehabilitation from IH 35 to 16 Miles North (Webb County) - \$61.5 million.

MAINTENANCE: We spend \$15.3 million annually on seal coating projects and in-house operations. We also spend several million each year rehabilitating I-35 pavement.

CORRIDORS: The Laredo District's priority corridor efforts are IH 35, US 59 (Loop 20/Future I-69W) and Ports to Plains (US 83 and US 277).

SAFETY: Safety projects total \$11.6 million to include traffic signal upgrades, flashing beacons, safety lighting, wrong way driver technology, and installation of raised medians.
