

US 69 WIDENING PROJECT




US 69 Widening Project Overview


- Widening US 69
- Project Limits: from FM 844 0 to FM 1270
- Project Scope
 - Widen existing 2 lane roadway to 4 lane divide roadway
 - Grade separation (Overpass) in Zavalla at SH 63/US69 Intersection
- Project Goals
 - Improve safety, mobility and congestion during Hurricane evacuations

US 69 Widening Project Overview

Existing Typical Section

US 69 Widening Project Overview

- May 2018 letting – Begin Construction Summer 2018
- Anticipated construction timeline of four years, completion Summer 2022
- Current Construction Estimate = \$78.5 million

US 69 Widening Project Overview

- Estimated Quantities
 - 526,000 cy of excavation
 - 586,000 cy of embankment
 - 258,000 tons Flexible Base
 - 154,000 tons of HMAC
 - 286,000 sf of bridge
 - 6,600 lf of drainage culverts
 - 6,400 lf of drainage pipe
 - 26 ea of drainage inlets, manholes, junction boxes
 - 4,800 lf of concrete barrier

US 69 Widening Project Overview

- Other items included in the project:
 - Removal of Concrete Items:
 - Paving, Riprap, and Medians
 - Removal of Structure Items:
 - Headwalls and Pipes
 - Guardrail End Treatment: Install and remove
 - Detour pavement
 - Crash Cushion Attenuator: Install, move, reset and remove
 - Lighting, Small and Large Signs

SFA Purchasing Thresholds

- *Informal Solicitations*

\$10,000.01-\$25,000.00

a. Solicit at least 3 vendors (50% must be a HUB)

- *Formal Solicitations*

over \$25,000.00 (Try to solicit 50% HUBs)

ITB-Invitation to Bid

RFP-Request for Proposal

RFQ-Request for Qualifications

A Solicitation is not required if products or services are covered under an existing contract. Contracts are listed on our SFA Procurement website.(Cooperative, State, and SFA)
