Notice of Public Meeting

A public meeting to discuss proposed improvements to a segment of East Loop 338 is scheduled from 5 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Tuesday, January 12, 2016, at the Odessa District Office of TxDOT, 3901 E. Highway 80.

The project focuses on East Loop 338 between Trunk Street and Business Interstate 20 in Ector County. The discussion will include the possibility of traffic signals, service road usage, local traffic patterns and other possible improvements.

The public meeting is designed to both provide information about the proposed improvements as well as gather input from the public. Maps of the project area and other displays will be available for review and comment. TxDOT staff and consultants working on the project will be available to answer questions. The meeting will consist of an Open House from 5 p.m. to 6 p.m., followed by a brief presentation at 6 p.m. and a question-and-answer session.

The proposed improvements are needed to address increased commercial traffic in the area.

Union Pacific is a key funding partner in the project.
