The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), in conjunction with the City of Alton, is proposing improvements to Farm-to-Market (FM) 676 (Mile 5 N Rd.), from State Highway (SH) 364 (La Homa Rd.) to SH 107 in Hidalgo County, Texas. TxDOT is the lead agency that will approve the environmental review of this project. The total distance of the project is approximately 2.5 miles. The meeting details are as follows:



The proposed project would include the widening of FM 676 from a two lane roadway to a four lane curb and gutter roadway with a two-way left turn lane, sidewalks, and drainage structures. The purpose of the proposed project would be to add capacity and to improve safety for traffic operations along the corridor. The majority of the proposed project would be done within the existing right of way (ROW). Approximately 1.8 acres of new ROW would be acquired at major intersections to improve traffic and pedestrian movements. Although additional right of way is required, no residential or non-residential structures would be displaced. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and the tentative schedule for right of way acquisition may be obtained from the TxDOT Pharr District Office at the address listed below.

Location maps, geometric design, and other information concerning this project will be available to the public from Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. at the TxDOT Pharr District Office located at 600 West Interstate 2, Pharr, Texas 78577.
