The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is developing a Texas Rail Plan to guide future actions by the public and private sectors to expand mobility of people and goods on rail, and meet federal and state legislative requirements. This Texas Rail Plan is being coordinated with the Statewide Long-Range Transportation Plan, TxDOT's look at the future of all transportation modes in Texas, also being developed this summer.
