Project Overview








- Expand LP 1604 from a 4-lane Divided Facility to a 4-lane Expressway with continuous frontage roads
- Construct new overpasses at Marbach Rd and Dove Canyon / Falcon Wolf
- Construct LP 1604 SB to US 90 EB Direct Connector (Flyover)
- Project length approximately 4.5 miles


Typical Section



- Project was included in the \$825 Million 5 - Year Mobility Plan announced in January 2014
- Collaborative effort between agencies:
 - VIA/Advanced Transportation District
 - TxDOT
 - Bexar County
 - City of San Antonio
 - Alamo Regional Mobility Authority
 - Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization



ENVIRONMENTAL OVERVIEW

Loop 1604

Need

- Congestion along LP 1604 and projected increases in traffic

Purpose

- Improve mobility and reduce congestion for the traveling public

Environmental Assessment

- No new right-of-way required
- No residential or commercial displacements
- No disproportionately high or adverse effects on minority, limited English proficiency, or low-income populations are anticipated
- Traffic noise analysis is currently underway



Environmental Assessment

- No impacts to air quality, wetlands, floodwater storage, or hazardous materials are anticipated
- No impacts to archeological resources/sites or historic resources are anticipated
- Coordination with the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department and US Fish and Wildlife Service will be conducted
