LOOP 1604: From US 90 to FM 1957 (Potranco Road)

Project Details

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold an open house to present proposed improvements to Loop 1604 between US 90 and FM 1957 (Potranco Road). Improvements are needed due to high traffic counts and congestion. The proposed project would expand Loop 1604 to a four-lane expressway (non-toll lanes). Improvements would include the construction of the southbound Loop 1604 mainlanes and frontage road, entrance and exit ramps, a direct connector (flyover) from southbound Loop 1604 to eastbound US 90, and overpasses or underpasses to separate traffic at the intersections of US 90, Marbach Road, and Dove Canyon. The proposed project will be constructed within existing right-of-way, therefore there will be no displacements.

Open House

The public is invited to attend the open house to view project maps, visit with team members, ask questions, and share comments. The meeting is an open house format and no formal presentation will be given, so attendees can come at their convenience.

All comments must be received or postmarked by Friday, September 25, 2015 for inclusion in the Open House Record using one of the following methods:


