

# US 90 Project Location



- Need


- Pedestrians frequently cross the controlled access freeway, leading to pedestrian-vehicle collisions

- Purpose

- Provide a safe pedestrian crossing over US 90 and pedestrian connectivity along US 90

- Project selected as a Statewide Improvement
- Total Estimated Project Cost: \$4 Million

# Typical Section



## Proposed Pedestrian Bridge Generally Includes:

- Pedestrian crosswalk
- Pedestrian rail
- Omega fence fabric or equivalent
- Bridge structure and accompanying ramps on either side

# Project Description

- Location of proposed pedestrian bridge
  - Bridge structure
  - Ramps on both North and South sides
  - Pedestrian crosswalk, pedestrian rail, and fence fabric



# Environmental Assessment

The following environmental factors will be studied as part of the environmental impacts analysis process:

- Threatened and endangered species
- Streams, wetlands, floodplains
- Archeological and historic resources
- Socioeconomic resources
- Hazardous materials sites
- Vegetation
