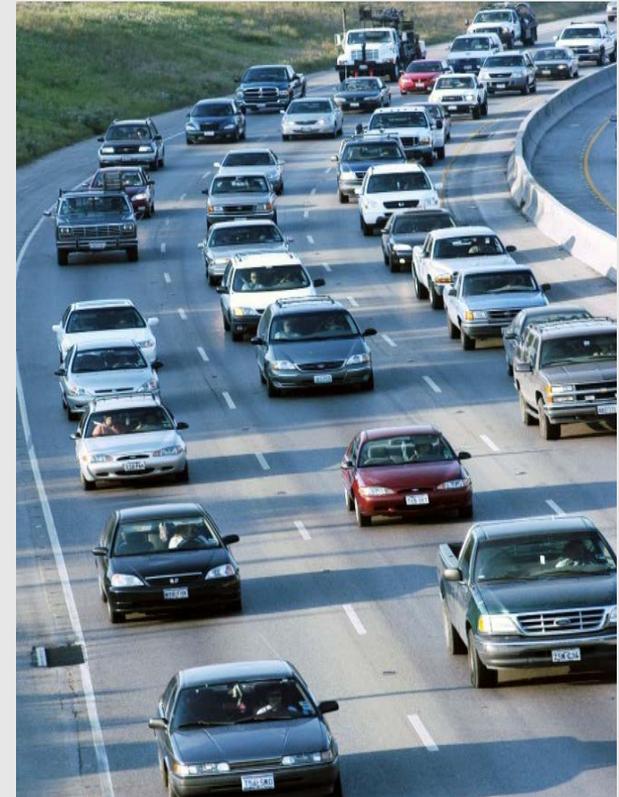



# PROJECT OVERVIEW

# Project Overview




- Expand to 4 lane roadway with continuous left turn lane
- Construct bicycle lanes and sidewalks
- Project length approximately 1.3 miles
- No new right-of-way or displacements
- Project costs about \$4.9 million

# Existing Road – Typical Section

The current road includes:


- Two 12-foot lanes (one lane in each direction)
- Two 5-foot outside shoulders



# Proposed Road – Typical Section

## The proposed road includes:

- Four 11-foot lanes (two lanes in each direction)
- One 12-foot continuous center turn lane
- Two 5-foot bike lanes (one on each outside edge of the road)
- Two 5-foot sidewalks (one on each side of the road)



## Project Information

- Project is funded with local, state, and federal funds
- Project funding was provided through the Alamo Area MPO call for projects



# ENVIRONMENTAL OVERVIEW

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FM 306

## Need

The proposed project will improve traffic operations within the project limits. According to traffic analysis, the number of vehicles using the FM 306 facility will increase substantially over the next 20 years.

## Purpose

The proposed project will improve the road capacity by adding two lanes and a center turn lane. These improvements will also bring the road up to current design standards.

# Environmental Assessment

- No new right-of-way required
- No residential or commercial displacements
- No disproportionately high or adverse effects on minority, limited English proficiency, or low-income populations are anticipated
- Traffic noise analysis is currently underway



# Environmental Assessment

- No impacts to air quality, wetlands, floodwater storage, or hazardous materials are anticipated
- No impacts to archeological resources/sites or historic resources are anticipated
- Coordination with the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department and US Fish and Wildlife Service will be conducted

\$4.5 Million
