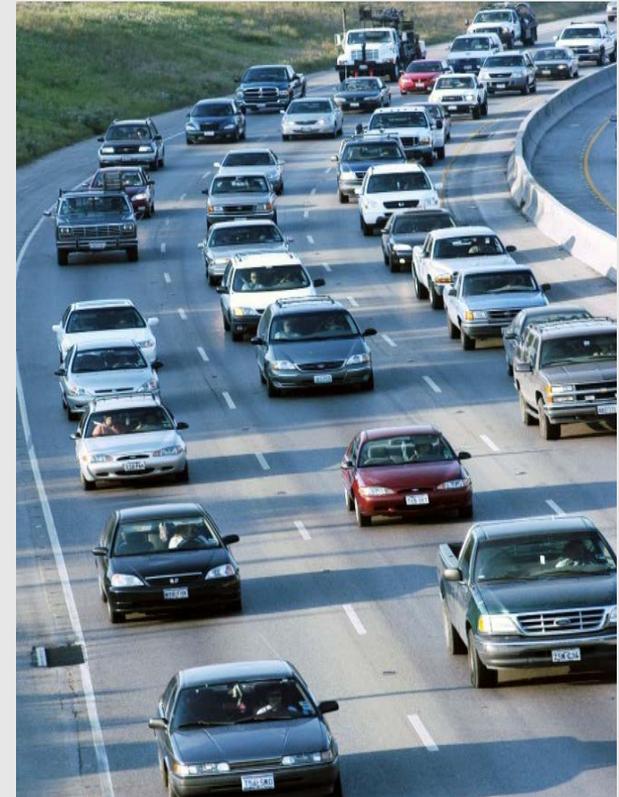



# Project Location Map




## ■ Need

- The population of Boerne projected to double in size between the years 2013 and 2040 (TWDB, 2015)
- Traffic expected to increase by 50 percent (from 14,200 to 21,600 vehicles per day) between the years 2017 and 2037
- Limited pedestrian and bicycle facilities within the SH 46 corridor

## ■ Purpose

- Improve existing traffic congestion and mobility as the population and traffic in the area increase
- Improve mobility and traffic operations for motorists, pedestrians, and bicyclists


# Existing Typical Section



Existing SH 46 from Esser Road to Ammann Road Includes:

- Two 11' travel lanes (one in each direction)
- Two 8' outside shoulders
- One 12' continuous two-way left turn lane
- Open ditches

# Proposed Typical Section



## Proposed SH 46 from Esser Road to Ammann Road Includes:

- Four 11' travel lanes (two in each direction)
- One 12' continuous two-way left turn lane
- Two 5' bike lanes (one in each direction)
- Adding curbs and sidewalk along both sides of road
- Construct underground storm sewer from Esser Road to Ammann Road

Studies are underway to evaluate potential impacts of the proposed project on social and environmental resources, including:

- Historic-age Resources
- Archeological Resources
- Parks
- Cemeteries
- Threatened and Endangered Species
- Vegetation
- Water Resources

- Commercial and Residential Properties
- Socioeconomics and Community Cohesion
- Air Quality
- Traffic Noise
- Hazardous Materials
- Section 4(f) Properties

In compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), TxDOT is preparing environmental documentation to detail these studies, assess potential impacts, and outline avoidance and mitigation measures.


