

Texas has the largest road network in the country and TxDOT maintains more lane-miles of pavement than any other state DOT

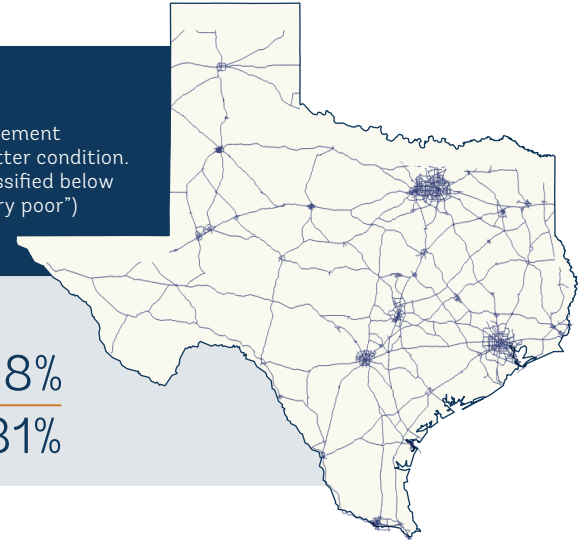
Texas Road Network Quick Facts

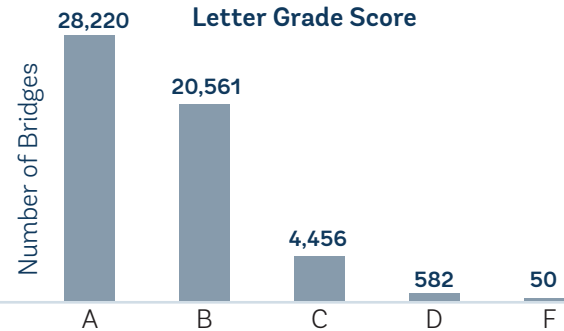

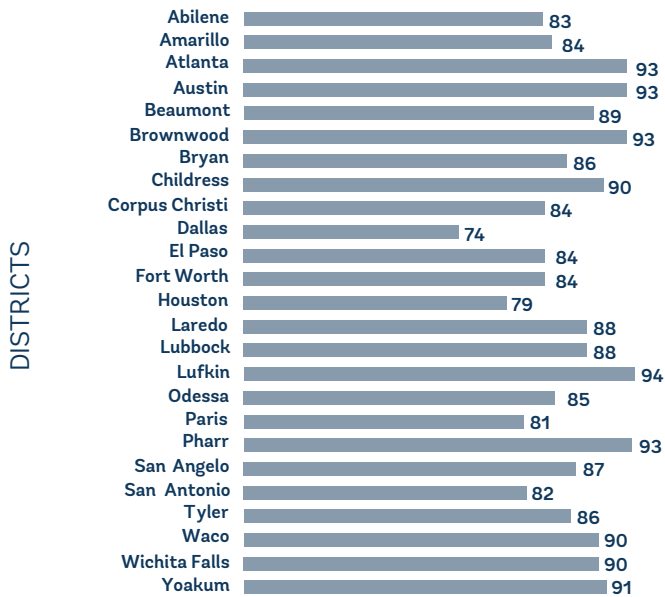


Number of Bridges in State Condition Score Groups

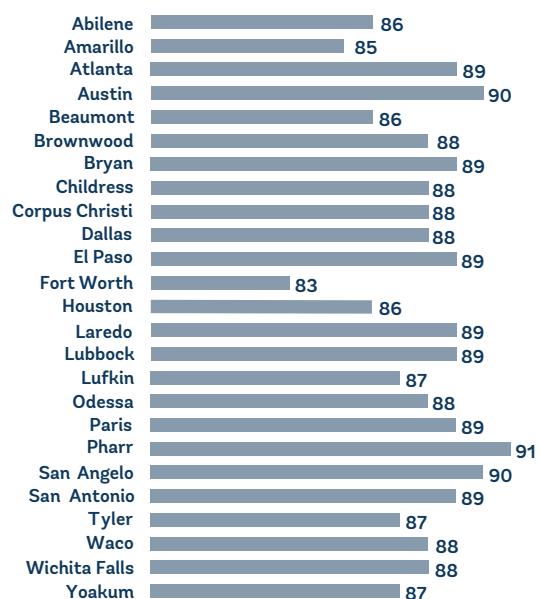
2017 Pavement Condition by TxDOT District
