

Recently the Texas Department of Transportation notified the City of Amarillo that additional funds had been made available for Amarillo's local public transit provider. These Section 5307 funds from the Governor's Apportionment were released on June 23, 2010.

To acknowledge the revised funding allocation, the Amarillo Metropolitan Planning Organization has made an administrative revision to the Amarillo 2008–2011 Transportation Improvement Program. The change reflects the redistribution of funds released to the 5307 transit agencies for FY 2010. Support materials are attached. These materials include a revised Project Listing and a Transit Financial Summary, both effective July 12, 2010.

Attached is a list showing the FY 2010 funding allocations for the individual Section 5307 transit operators in Texas from the Governor's Apportionment. The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) used the apportionment published in the May 13, 2010 Federal Register.

The Lower Rio Grande Development Council (LRGVDC), as the Designated Recipient for the Harlingen-San Benito urbanized area has notified TxDOT that they will release \$671,561 of their FY 2007 funds, and \$391,866 of their FY 2008 funds, for a total of \$1,063,427. Consistent with my letter of April 1, 2009, these funds are requested to be transferred to Brownsville.

In addition, the City of Port Arthur has notified TxDOT that they will release \$946,929 of their FY 2010 funds. The 2010 released funds are requested to be allocated pro-rata to the applicable 5307 transit agencies.

The attachment reflects redistribution of the released funds to the 5307 transit agencies for FY 2010. Please rescind the allocations in my letter of June 10, and issue the FY 2010 grants in the amounts shown.

We are notifying the appropriate Section 5307 operators by a separate letter. If you have any questions or require additional information, please call Linda Gonzalez at (512) 374-5242.
