

INTRODUCTION

Since May 10, 1973, policy directive for transportation planning within the Sherman-Denison Urban Area has been carried out under the direction and guidance of the Transportation Policy Board, which was established by agreement between the State, Grayson County and the cities of Denison and Sherman.

A. PURPOSE - In accordance with SAFETEA-LU Section(s) 1107, 6001, 23 USC 104,134, the MPO, in cooperation with the State and affected transit operators, has developed this transportation improvement program (TIP) for the Sherman-Denison Metropolitan area. The purpose of this document is to provide the public, FHWA, and other interested parties with a priority list of projects and project segments to be carried out within a 4-year period after the adoption of the TIP. A financial plan is part of this document. This financial plan demonstrates how the TIP can be implemented, and indicates resources from public and private sources that are reasonably expected to be made available to carry out the program. The TIP is updated at least every year and is approved by the MPO and the Governor of Texas.

B. DEFINITION OF AREA - The Sherman-Denison Urbanized Area consists of the cities of Sherman, Denison, Howe, Pottsboro and Van Alstyne. The northern boundary is the Red River/Oklahoma border and touches Lake TEXOMA, Eisenhower State Park and the Hagerman National Wildlife Refuge. US HWY 75 running North/South basically splits the area in half and US HWY 82 running East/West intersects US HWY 75 and splits the urban area into quadrants. The City of Dallas is approximately 70 miles to the south. The population of the area is about 63,200 and is completely inside Grayson County.

C. PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT PROCESS - The Transportation Policy Board has approved Public Involvement Procedures

for the MPO, as required by the SAFETEA-LU. These procedures include advertising in local communication media and maintaining a current mailing list of those persons who are interested in the transportation process. All meetings are advertised and are open to the public. To foster an atmosphere of public cooperation and in the spirit of the SAFETEA-LU, the MPO staff actively participates in several organizations, including the Chambers of Commerce and the TEXOMA Transportation Club. The staff have spoken at various civic organizations and have been guest speakers at Austin College.

Before approval of the TIP, the MPO will provide citizens, affected public agencies, representatives of transportation agency employees, private providers of transportation, and other interested parties with reasonable notice of an opportunity to comment on the proposed program.

D. PROJECT SELECTION PROCESS - Having been created in 1984, the Sherman-Denison MPO is a relatively new transportation-planning agency. The Sherman-Denison metropolitan area is also among the smallest populations designated to be served by an MPO in the state of Texas. As a result, much reliance must be placed on the expertise of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) during the project selection process. The Paris district office and the Sherman Area office of TxDOT have historically determined how funding is to be allocated among potential project candidates within the county, pending discussion with appropriate public officials. As Grayson County continues to grow, the MPO has slowly developed the capacity to function as a participant in project selection decision-making.

Dialogue between the MPO and TxDOT regarding project selection procedures has continued. Due to the short-range nature of the TIP and the amount of time it takes to move a project through the feasibility, funding and design processes, TxDOT must take the lead in developing the TIP. The main objective of the Transportation Policy Board, serving as the MPO, should be to determine that community consensus regarding the utilization of funds extended to the county has been reached. Constructive input is more likely to benefit the community when MPO input is communicated to TxDOT during the development of the Unified Transportation Plan (UTP). The UTP is prepared to identify projects 10 years in advance, and MPO or public input could be more realistically incorporated into a system improvement strategy than at the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) stage, when project development is approaching funding and implementation authorization clearance.

The Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) should be the primary planning tool for selecting major projects to be included in the UTP and TIP. Only projects that are consistent with the 2030 MTP may be selected for the TIP.

The TIP is consistent with the MTP for the Sherman-Denison Urban Transportation Study and will be submitted to the Transportation Policy Board for approval. Full funding is reasonably anticipated to be available for each project within the time period contemplated for completion of the project.

In accordance with Section 133 (h)(2) of Title 23 U.S.C. as amended, the Sherman-Denison Urban Transportation Study MPO Transportation Policy Board hereby approved the following Project Selection Procedures:

- 1) The approved Transportation Improvement Program shall be utilized for programming projects within the urban area.
- 2) Any project listed in the first year of the approved Transportation Improvement Program shall be considered the highest priority and may be implemented as soon as plans are completed and funds are appropriated. Projects in the second, third and fourth years of the TIP are considered to have second, third and fourth priorities, respectively.
- 3) If a project in the first year cannot be accomplished, the a project or projects from the second year will be selected and those projects may be initiated as plans are completed and funds are appropriated.

F. AIR QUALITY ISSUES - The Sherman-Denison Metropolitan area is in conformity with the Clean Air Act as Amended.

G. AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) - The Texoma Paratransit System (TAPS) insures total accessibility to transit services provided by scheduling demand-

response service (including riders, vehicles and drivers) the day before and maintaining sufficient number and availability of accessible vehicles to meet all requests for accessible service with no delays and no waiting lists. The multi-modal intercity bus facility is a fully accessible bus, small urban transit, and rural transit passenger facility.


Grouped Project CSJs

The Texas Department of Transportation is holding two public hearing meetings this week, one being co-hosted by the Sherman-Denison Metropolitan Planning Organization held locally, and the other held at TxDOT headquarters in Austin.

Wednesday, the MPO and TxDOT are inviting the public to the Texoma Council of Governments Building, Governments Room, 1117 Gallagher in Sherman at 5:30 p.m. The top of the public involvement meeting is to discuss, get information on or give public comments on the draft of the fiscal year 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program. TCOG explained in a press release this is a staged, multi-year listing of surface transportation projects proposed for funding by federal, state and local sources within the Sherman-Denison study area.

Information on TIP is on the MPO Website, www.sdmpo.org, at the Sherman-Denison MPO offices inside the TCOG building or at the TxDOT offices, U.S. Highway 75 south of FM 1417 on the west service road.

The meeting is scheduled to

last about an hour and is open to anyone interested in TIP. Verbal or written comments will be accepted. These can be presented at the meeting or within 10 calendar days afterward. appropriations for Fiscal 2007 rescinded more than \$3.4 billion in previously authorized transportation funds across the nation. TxDOT has been advised Texas will be required to return approximately \$290 million in non-obligated federal-aid highway funds.

This meeting will begin at 9 a.m. Thursday at the TxDOT headquarters in Austin, 125 East 11th Street.

"We want to hear from the public on how we should prepare to absorb these funding cuts," said Mike Behrens, TxDOT executive director. "We would like to have as little impact as possible on our ability to meet our goals to reduce congestion, enhance safety, expand economic opportunity, improve air quality and increase the value of transportation assets."

TxDOT anticipates it will have less than a month to respond once official notice comes from Washington, according to Behrens, who added that, during the last 15 months, Texas has returned \$905 million in response to federal funding cuts.


The City of Sherman has reviewed the draft 2008/2011 Transportation Improvement Program plan and budget. We are in general agreement with the projects proposed in the plan; however, we would like to bring another issue to your attention that needs consideration by the Transportation Policy Board and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT).

Highway 131, from U.S. Highway 75 to Northcreek Drive, is a heavily traveled highway, and increasingly so as retail development in the area expands. We are especially concerned about the traffic safety problem developing at Highway 131, Canyon Grove Road and the U.S. Highway 82 overpass. Additionally, the City has informed TxDOT in the past that the section of pavement between U.S. Highway 75 and Taylor Street is badly deteriorated and needs, at the very least, a mill and overlay. But on a broader scale, the entire corridor needs to be studied and plans developed for its improvement full length.

We understand that the planning and funding cycle for projects of this nature take a considerable amount of time. We urge you to take a closer look at this particular section of Highway 131 and support the City in establishing this as a future priority project.
