

Dear Mr. Kabobel:

At the Policy Board Meeting of the Metropolitan Planning Organization, Waco Urban Transportation Study held on November 2, 2009, the board voted unanimously to amend the 2008 - 2011 Transportation Improvement Program. The amendment removes CSJ 0258-09-111 and adds CSJs 0015-21-010 and 2506-01-027. Both project additions are entirely funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). Please find enclosed five original copies.

In addition, the Policy Board also authorized TxDOT to use ARRA funds on 3 maintenance / rehab projects in the case of cost underruns or unforeseen delays regarding the aforementioned CSJs. These projects are included in a separate list. Please note that since the MPO incorporates maintenance / rehab projects into grouped CSJs, the Policy Board action does not amend the TIP to include these projects as they are already considered a part of the TIP.
